

1. _____ **Complete a FREE Application for Admission**
 - a. Go to www.dmacc.edu .
 - b. Select “Apply Now” on the right side.
 - c. Apply as a “New Student” even if you took DMACC courses as a high school student.

2. _____ **Complete Assessments for Your Program at DMACC**
 - a. DMACC requires assessments for specific programs and courses.
 - b. You can see your admissions checklist by accessing **myDMACC**. Some programs have additional requirements and your admissions checklist will let you know what you need to finish.

3. _____ **Apply for Financial Aid - Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**
 - a. Complete FAFSA online at fafsa.gov.
 - b. Apply after October 1, 2021 for the 2022-2023 academic year. The deadline to complete the FAFSA for some federal and state grants including Last-Dollar Scholarship is July 1, 2022.
 - c. Submit additional forms as requested by the DMACC Financial Aid office. This information can be viewed in **myDMACC** and should be completed as soon as possible.

4. _____ **Apply for DMACC Foundation Scholarships**
 - a. Complete the application at <https://dmacc.academicworks.com/>.
 - b. Application for the 2022-2023 academic year opens November 1st. Deadline is **March 1, 2022**.

5. _____ **Attend Orientation and Register for Classes**
 - a. You will receive an email about completing an online orientation through Blackboard.
 - b. Once you complete the online orientation, you may be asked to come to campus to register for classes or you may be able to register on your own depending on your campus and program.
