Harold's family fixed up his classic 1957 Farmall 450 that he bought new in 1958 because he wanted to go on a tractor rides during the summer of 2016, but our good Lord had different plans. This organization prides itself in remembering and honoring all of the good times, hard work, and hours that Harold spent on the farm, as well as volunteering in local organizations, such as his hometown church, and serving on several different supervisor boards over his lifetime. The Annual Tractor Ride is what funds this scholarship, and the family and officers of the Harold King Memorial Tractor Ride, Inc. highly encourage you, or your family to check out our annual ride, which is held on the first Saturday of June. If you do not have a tractor – do not worry – we have a trolley that is pulled by the lead tractor as well!

Two area High School scholarship applicants will receive, one of two scholarships - either a \$250, or \$500 scholarship to help defer the cost of their continuing education. Please see last page of packet for qualifying counties.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking graduating students pursuing a degree in agriculture, or agricultural related field.
- * Students must have a record of volunteerism in the community, in non-school sponsored activities, <u>and</u> participation in extracurricular school activities.
- * Applicants must plan to attend a two (2)-year community college or four (4)-year college or university.
- * Applicants must be active participants in their church, as volunteers, board members, Sunday school teachers, music coordinators, or other actively participating roles within their church.
- * Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- * Applicants must have a letter of recommendation from the following people stating why the applicant should be selected for this scholarship: a teacher, a community member, and a member or person affiliated with their church.
- *Applicants must provide a school **OR** senior picture with their application.
- *Applications must be post-marked <u>OR</u> received by the Harold King Memorial Tractor Ride officers no later than March 20, 2023. *Late applications will not be accepted.*
- * The Harold King Memorial Tractor Ride officers will issue a check in the month of **August 2023 directly to the scholarship applicant's college**, not to the student themselves. The scholarship funds will be issued to the college or university upon receiving a certificate of enrollment for the fall semester, which includes the Student ID number and Financial Aid Office address.

The applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by the Board of Directors of the Harold King Memorial Tractor Ride in conjunction with Harold's immediate family members. The scholarship winners will be announced on *April 20*, *2023* on our Facebook Page. All applicants will also receive a letter via United States Postal Service regarding their scholarship submission.
