

Katie Van Horn Memorial Scholarship

Scholarship Definition

Katherine RosaLee (Katie) Van Horn was born on October 3, 2003 and went home to God's loving arms on October 5, 2003. She was a blessing and will be remembered fondly. This scholarship was started in her memory by her parents in the 2009-2010 school year of Glidden-Ralston when she would have started Kindergarten.

Requirements:

1. Only students in their Senior year of Glidden-Ralston High School are eligible.
2. The scholarship will be awarded based on the application and its completeness. **HINTS:** Using correct grammar (spelling, word usage, capitalization and punctuation) make for a more "complete" application. Also, since you will need to do this in college, use a double (2) space after EVERY period and before the next sentence. Not only is it correct grammar, but makes your application easier to read - therefore, higher on the yes list!
3. The application must be legibly hand-written (or typed) by the applicant. Lined paper may be used. Applicant's name must be in top right corner of each additional sheet. If space permits, more than one question may be on the same sheet of paper.
4. The application must be turned in by May 1, 2022 to be eligible.

5. The scholarship recipient will be chosen by John and/or Cindi Van Horn (Katie's parents) or their designee.
6. The scholarship will be announced at the Senior Awards Night.
7. The amount of the scholarship will be up to \$300.00.
8. The payment of this scholarship will be paid after the beginning of your **second** semester of your first year of post-secondary education. You will be required to provide a copy of your first semester grade report/transcript and current enrollment verification at your post-secondary institution.
 - A. College student must be enrolled full-time to receive payment.
 - B. Any college grade lower than a "C" which cannot be explained sufficiently will void the scholarship.

Enclose a High School Transcript including all classes from Freshman through most recent term. Grades need to be included for all terms prior to the last current term.
